### EHNAC Approves Candidacy Status for Post-N-Track Corporation

**Middletown, CT January 4, 2007** – Post-N-Track Corporation announced today that the Electronic Healthcare Network Accreditation Commission (EHNAC) has approved its application for the EHNAC accreditation process. In Maryland and New Jersey, EHNAC accreditation is required of any entity processing healthcare transactions on behalf of healthcare organizations located in those states.

To achieve EHNAC accreditation, Post-N-Track® must submit to an independent evaluation of the organization's ability to perform at or above the legal and industry-established standards for the transmission of health information. EHNAC's accreditation process requires a rigorous assessment of compliance with current performance criteria verified by a site review and approval by the commission.

"Achieving EHNAC candidate status is a gratifying acknowledgement of the steps we've taken thus far to improve the quality of healthcare delivery through information technology," said Post-N-Track Founder & CEO Allen DeGraw. "We look forward to undertaking the EHNAC evaluation process and making continual strides in healthcare electronic transmission," DeGraw remarked.

Post-N-Track solutions allow providers to submit or 'post' healthcare transactions and information directly to payers and to receive or 'track' processing results - without an intermediary. Providers can check results online including receipt confirmations, acknowledgments, claims status and remittance notices. Post-N-Track also provides automated HIPAA validation for inbound claim files, and converts encrypted responses into "human-readable" messages.
