Effective immediately, all providers may submit their claims using this simple, secure HIPAA-compliant solution. The Post-N-Track solution allows health care providers to submit or 'post' their claims to Fidelis Care directly and securely over the Internet and receive or 'track' processing results, without an intermediary. Claims are submitted via a secure Web tunnel and delivered directly to Fidelis Care. Each claim file is treated as a separate transaction that is tracked from pickup to delivery, similar to a package sent by a delivery service. Providers can check results online with the Post-N-Track Claim Management Center™, including receipt confirmations, acknowledgments, claims status and remittance notices. Post-N-Track also provides automated HIPAA validation for inbound claim files, and converts encrypted responses into "human-readable" messages for providers.
